I, George Sanders, being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes and says;

That he is confined in the Utah State Prison on a charge of Grand Larceny, having been received from the Third Judicial District, County of Salt Lake, May 29th, 1923,

That his application for Termination was denied by the Board of Pardons at their meeting March 20th and 24th, 1925. That said denial was caused, I believe, by the fact that the descriptive matter placed before the Board constained the information that he was received in May, 1924; and that in an apparent attempt to remedy the error, the year '1925' was written instead.

That he has now served two years and two months of his sentence; that he has worked practically every day of the last year in the Overall Factory, and has won the respect and confidence of the officials of the Institution.

Wherefore, he now petitions the Honorable Board for a re-hearing of his application for Termination to the end that he may be granted his release at this time.
