Application of Edwin Slatter #4572

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~xx~~ Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of May A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City, Utah, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. M. McGree presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable S. G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edwin Slatter I was convicted under the name of Edwin Slatter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
