Application of Ed. Heater No. 5458

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of September  
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Robert J. McKinnon presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One Two Twenty Years  
in the Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison from  
Two Twenty Years

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward Leroy Heater

I was convicted under the name of Ed Heater

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery  
Sentenced to the Utah Prison June 1  
1925
