TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF PARSONS OF THE STATE OF UTAH:

Under date of November 26, 1923, the defendant, William Wallworth, entered a plea of guilty to the crime of an indecent assault upon Zelma Carter, a child of the age of twelve years, and was thereupon sentenced to serve a term of not less than five years in the state Prison. Mr. Wallworth is a man of mature years, and is partially parylized. He has been engaged in the repairing of bicycles here at Provo, and I am informed that for some time past has been in the habit of making indecent assaults upon young girls without, however, any attempt to commit a rape. From my observations of him while in court, I am of the opinion that he is defective mentally as well as physicially.

I recommend that he be imprisoned in the state prison for a period of nine months.
