Application of Ed Roa

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah St. Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Oct. A. D. 1923, at C. J. den County of Weber and State of Utah, in second Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one (1) to ten (10) years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Roa

I was convicted under the name of Ed. Roa
