Application of Raymond H. Lano

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the twenty fifth day of April A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Raymond H. Lano

I was convicted under the name of Raymond H. Lano
