and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of grand larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of April
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. H. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harold P. Grover
I was convicted under the name of Harold Grover

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Marion J. Whitney

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except third degree
burglary.
