I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a commutation of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 1st degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of January A. D. 1925, at Castle Dale County of Emery and State of Utah, in Seventh judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Willie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term of life imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison at Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is David M. Gregory I was convicted under the name of David M. Gregory

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
