I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Third day of October  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of \_\_\_\_\_  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of  
five years to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Frederick  
I was convicted under the name of Raymond Barrett

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny  
in New York, where I am now wanted for violation  
of Parole, to serve three more years of my unexpired  
sentence.
