
RE The State v John L Rupe and James R Bocock

On the 12th instant these defendants each pleaded guilty to the charge of Burglary in the Second Degree, and each was thereupon sentenced indeterminately.

The boys are transients. At the time of the commission of the crime they were returning from California to their homes in Oklahoma. They entered a dwelling house and took some food, bedding, a sheep-skin lined coat and a pair of shoes, all of which property was recovered.

I recommend the minimum term in the penitentiary.
