Application of Henry Smith

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of July A. D. 1925, at Castle Dale County of Emery and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Thurston presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months to 3 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Prosecutor Clay prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harvey Shannon I was convicted under the name of Henry Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: George Brown Emma Winger Carson Libby - Jones

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except State Embezzlement in the United States District Court St. Louis, Mo., 1914 Springfield Ill 1915
