Application of

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of October A. D. 1924, at Farmington County of Davis and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. M. Kimball presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to serve 1-20 years (recommendation of one year) and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Willy Saxon I was convicted under the name of "

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except 1917 burglary 5 years, San Quentin 1926 " " Folsom, Cal.
