I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of receiving stolen property

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of October
A. D. 1926, at Third Jud. Salt Lake County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from 1 to 5 years, with
recommendation to serve 2 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison of Utah,
and have served to date 2 years, 1 day.

Fourth-Honorable E. C. Rogers prosecuted the case.
