under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of August
A. D. 1923, at Niphi County of Juab
and State of Utah, in 5th Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. M. Burton presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to 6 Month To 3 Year.
To Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth--Honorable William B. Miggins prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of John Smiley
