Application of John Smiley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a *Rehearing*
Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of August
A. D. 1923, at Nephi County of Juab
and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence from
6 month to 3 year,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison from 28
day of August 1923.

Fourth-- Honorable Wm. B. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Smilyanich
I was convicted under the name of John Smiley

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except one Time Ten
month in State of California, for which I was not
responsible or guilty
