Application of Clarence Merton Kramer

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of July A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Walton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clarence Merton Kramer I was convicted under the name of Roy A. Smiley

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except I have never been convicted of a felony, but have been put in a county jail for minor offenses.
