Application of Frank Hernandez

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of voluntary manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of June  
A. D. 1923, at Beaver County of Beaver  
and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to and indeterminate term in the Utah State  
Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Hernandez  
I was convicted under the name of Frank Hernandez

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one above mentioned
