Application of Stanton Jessup

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of July A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathinson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 1 to 10 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Stanton Jessup
I was convicted under the name of Stanton Jessup

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Almo Weed and Rodney Gibson

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
