Sir and Gentlemen:

On November 3 1921 I arrested James Nickolopolous at his residence in this city on a charge of Murder. He shot thru a door killing a relative over some family difficulty. I was the complaining witness and also participated in the prosecution of his case.

The first trial resulted in a mis-trial on account of the jury being unable to agree on a verdict. He was later allowed to plead to a lesser degree, man - slaughter, and is now serving on the sentence as passed.

James Nickolopolous now seeks termination of his sentence and I believe, after consideration of his case, that the ends of Justice have been fulfilled and join in asking that his petition for termination be granted.
