First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the nineteenth day of June A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court-- Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. A. Peterson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term One to twenty and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Rogers prosecuted the case.
