Application of Lorenzo Hitesman

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a condemnation and termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the August 21st day of August
A. D. 1929, at Garden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Baker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to and indeterminate sentence
for Robbery
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Lorenzo Hitesman
I was convicted under the name of Lorenzo Hitesman

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except McNish
Island, State of Washington
Honorable Board of Pardons and Paroles
This crime happened in 1926 and I have been in
prison since that time, and have had no chance to do
right and I have to go back to McNish Island when

I am released from here.
I wish you gentlemen would hear
this deeply in mind as I am in poor
health. as I wish to go back to McNish
and finish my time so I can take care of
my health.
