Application of Fred B Ballender

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~Pardon~~ Rehearing and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of May A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term of from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joe C. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Fred B Ballender I was convicted under the name of Fred B Ballender

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
