I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Fourth day of Nov. A. D. 1932, at Logan County of Cache and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John G. Rundzak. I was convicted under the name of John G. Delorme.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Minor Offenses.
