I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of March
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to E. A. Rodgers Pres.
From 5 yrs to Life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Walter Mitchell
I was convicted under the name of Walter Mitchell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Charles Maura
Leland Ahlson

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Petit Larceny
