Application of Deportation Jose Estrada

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Deportation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of Sept A. D. 1924, at City of Salt Lake County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. M. McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an undetermined sentence from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ramon Palacios I was convicted under the name of Jose Estrada

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except once in San Quentin Cal. and once in Florence Ariz.
