First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of January
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An Indeterminate sentence
of one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable District Attorney J. E. Johnson prosecuted the case.
