THE COURT: What is your plea to this information, guilty or not guilty?

THE COURT: You may be seated just a moment, Mr. McCuaig. Sit down over there just a moment. Mr. Johnson, will you make a statement as to the facts in this case?

MR. JOHNSON: I will try, your Honor, if I can get this here cold. The defendant saw the money in the purse and Mrs. Sullivan took \$10.00 and gave it to one of the other boarders
