Application of Seland Olson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of March
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Jackson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Seland Howard Olson
I was convicted under the name of Seland Howard Olson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: W. Mitchell

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except State Industrial School
