Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of March
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. A. Johnson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Seland Howard Ekron
I was convicted under the name of Seland Ekron

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: W. Mitchell "now on parole"

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except State Industrial School
