Gentlemen:-

The writer has been informed that an inmate of the State Prison Okey Winemiller has applied to your Board for a termination of sentence, the same to be heard on Friday, the 26th day of June, 1925.

I prosecuted the case wherein he was found guilty of grand larceny by a jury before Judge M. L. Ritchie, Judge of the Third Judicial District Court, Salt Lake County, Utah some 21 months ago. It was a close question as to whether the defendant was guilty of petit larceny or grand larceny. There was nothing about the case which differed from the general run of cases of this class and there were no aggravated circumstances involved.

In my judgment, based upon my knowledge of the case, I would recommend that the defendant's application be granted.
