Application of Okey Winemiller

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term of from 1 to 10 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Okey James Winemiller  
I was convicted under the name of Okey Winemiller

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Harry B. Bailey

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This one and I  
am not guilty of this one
