Application of Okey Winemiller.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Sentence of one to ten years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth -- Honorable Mr. Ross Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Okey Winemiller.  
I was convicted under the name of Okey Winemiller.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry B. Bailey.

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except Present one.
