First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of Oct A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. P. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Ross Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Okey Winemiller
I was convicted under the name of " "

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry B. Bailey

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
My reasons for asking for a rehearing are that I am badly in need of an operation, that the money for my transportation home is now in the office and that I have now served the minimum of my sentence.
