Application of Eldon Smith

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February  
A. D. 1925, at Castle Dale County of Emery  
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not less than one year  
and not more than twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State  
Prison on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of  
February, 1925

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arthur Jensen  
I was convicted under the name of Eldon Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
