and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery and Parole Violation

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 70th day of May
A. D. 1934, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. A. Wade presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 5 years to Life and parole revoked
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Wade M. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Eldon Chester Smith

I was convicted under the name of Eldon Chester Smith

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Harold Hornecker Tribe - acquitted

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows.
