First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19 day of June
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wm. M. Crea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel Clauson prosecuted the case.
