On the 19th instant this man entered a plea of guilty to a charge of forgery and was on said day sentenced indeterminately.

He came to Ogden recently from Wyoming. He is a railroad switchman. In one of the Union Depot offices at Ogden he picked up a pay check belonging to James L. Johns, a brother switchman, later forged Johns's endorsement thereto and then cashed the check at Wrights. Johns was in the office at the time the check was stolen.

I recommend one year's imprisonment.
