under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 nd. day of July
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A.R. Barnes presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Ross Hutchison prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Miss June Adams.

I was convicted under the name of Maxine Williams

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

I have been on Parole for One year. I have reported to
Warden Devine on the 1st of each month.
