Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of June

and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the  
Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. F. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Leith Settle Armitage  
I was convicted under the name of Leith Settle Armitage

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
