Application of Firth Armitage 4429

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~in~~ on Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of June, A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Firth Armitage  
I was convicted under the name of Firth Armitage

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Gabriel Ohlander, and Donald Mowery

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
