First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of January

and State of Utah, in the Fifth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thos. H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to
twenty years, with a recommendation of one year.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
