I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of August
A. D. 1923, at Fogel Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McGregor presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Glen W. Johnson
I was convicted under the name of Glen W. Johnson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: one minor

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a misdemeanor
