

THE COURT: Was anyone arrested with you for this offense?

DEFENDANT: Why, there was another boy, a juvenile.

THE COURT: A what?

DEFENDANT: There was one other, a juvenile.

THE COURT: You say you took the car with the intention of returning it. Why did you take it in the first instance then?

DEFENDANT: We wanted to go to Grantsville to a dance.

THE COURT: What did the Juvenile Court do with your partner, do you know?

DEFENDANT: I don't know.

MR. ROGERS: What was the name?

DEFENDANT: Dalley, I think.

MR. ROGERS: I understand, your honor, that no disposition has been made of the case against Dalley by the Juvenile Court.

THE COURT: When you were released on this other charge why didn't you return to Delta?

DEFENDANT: I got a job at the International Smelter in Tooele and was working there at the time.

THE COURT: Were you working there at the time of this offense?

DEFENDANT: Yes, sir.

THE COURT: Well, of course, on a plea of guilty to this offense there is no discretion in my as judge, except to sentence you to the Utah State Penitentiary for an indeterminate term, in the absence of any other recommendation from the State.

MR. ROGERS: We have no definite recommendation to make, your honor. Your honor has all the information concerning this defendant which we have.
