Application of PETER DeHEER

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Weber County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Unlawful possession of liquor

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February A. D. 1925, at Birch Creek County of Weber and State of Utah, in Justice Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Alfred Gladwell presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve sixty days and thereafter was imprisoned in the Weber County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel C. Powell prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Peter DeHeer I was convicted under the name of John DeHeer (John Jones)

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none

I plead guilty to having liquor on my premises. I was induced to let another party set up a still and manufacture liquor on a place that I am leasing just South of Ogden. I have a wife and 5 children who are at present in destitute circumstances.

My wife is also about to give birth to another child. I have never had any trouble before this. I realize that I have done wrong and have already paid for my Respectfully submitted, misdoings.
