Gentlemen:

I notice that an application for pardon has been made by one Peter DeHeer, convicted of violation of the prohibition law. As I recall, his sentence was sixty days in the County Jail.

I desire to interpose an objection to his application. In view of the facts surrounding this case, I think the sentence was light and that he merits the judgment passed by the court. It appears to me that the best solution to the enforcement of the prohibition law is jail penalties. In this case, as I recall, a large quantity of mash and parts of a still were found on his premises. I think it only proper that he should serve the time given him in the County Jail.
