under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15 day of January
A. D. 1923, at Logan County of Cache
and State of Utah, in First Judicial Dist Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Rusk prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Fred Weber
I was convicted under the name of Fred Weber
