To the Honorable the Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:
The petition of O.D. Wolfe and Ernest L. Wolfe respectfully
show to your Honorable Board.

I. That Petitioners are the brother and father of the
above named applicant, and that Petitioners are now, and for two
years last past, have been residents of Gowlitz County, State of
Washington, and that many years ago the applicant herein took his
mother's name, that of "Logan", but applicant is the son of O.D.
Wolfe and the full brother of Ernest L. Wolfe the Petitioners.

2. That Petitioner is now, and for more than twenty-five
years prior hereto has been engaged in the contracting business in
