Application of Nelson G. Tinnin.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of fictitious check.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Eleventh day of April A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Nelson George Tinnin. I was convicted under the name of Nelson George Tinnin.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
