

Salt Lake City, Utah, Nov. 19, 1923: 192

Application of Joe McKee

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah, State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Thirteenth day of July
A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term of from Six Mo. to Three
Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joe McKee
I was convicted under the name of Joe McKee
