First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17 day of May  
A. D. 1924, at Morgan County of Morgan  
and State of Utah, in a second judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of from  
1 to 20 years with a recommend for leniency  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison my recommend  
shows in the court records

Fourth-- Honorable Prosecuting Att. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is C. F. Caldwell

I was convicted under the name of Chas. Fredrick Caldwell

been in trouble before of any kind  
also I have worked every day since I  
entered institution and never been in  
trouble of any kind here
